THE CCHC *Community* LOTTERY

HOW IT WORKS

Tickets cost £2 per month.

Each £2 entry will be allocated a permanent number which is entered into a monthly draw.

Any one can join - friends, family, supporters - you just need to be over 18!

Subscribers can buy as many numbers as they wish.

Subscribers can pay monthly or annually.

Any entries for the draw must be made by the 27th day of the month.

All funds received up to the 27th day of the month will be the monthly pot.

The draw will take place on the first Saturday of the month.

The monthly pot will be split 40:60 between prizes and funds for CCHC.



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Please note, the CCHC Community Lottery is separate to, and different from, the Teamo Lottery.

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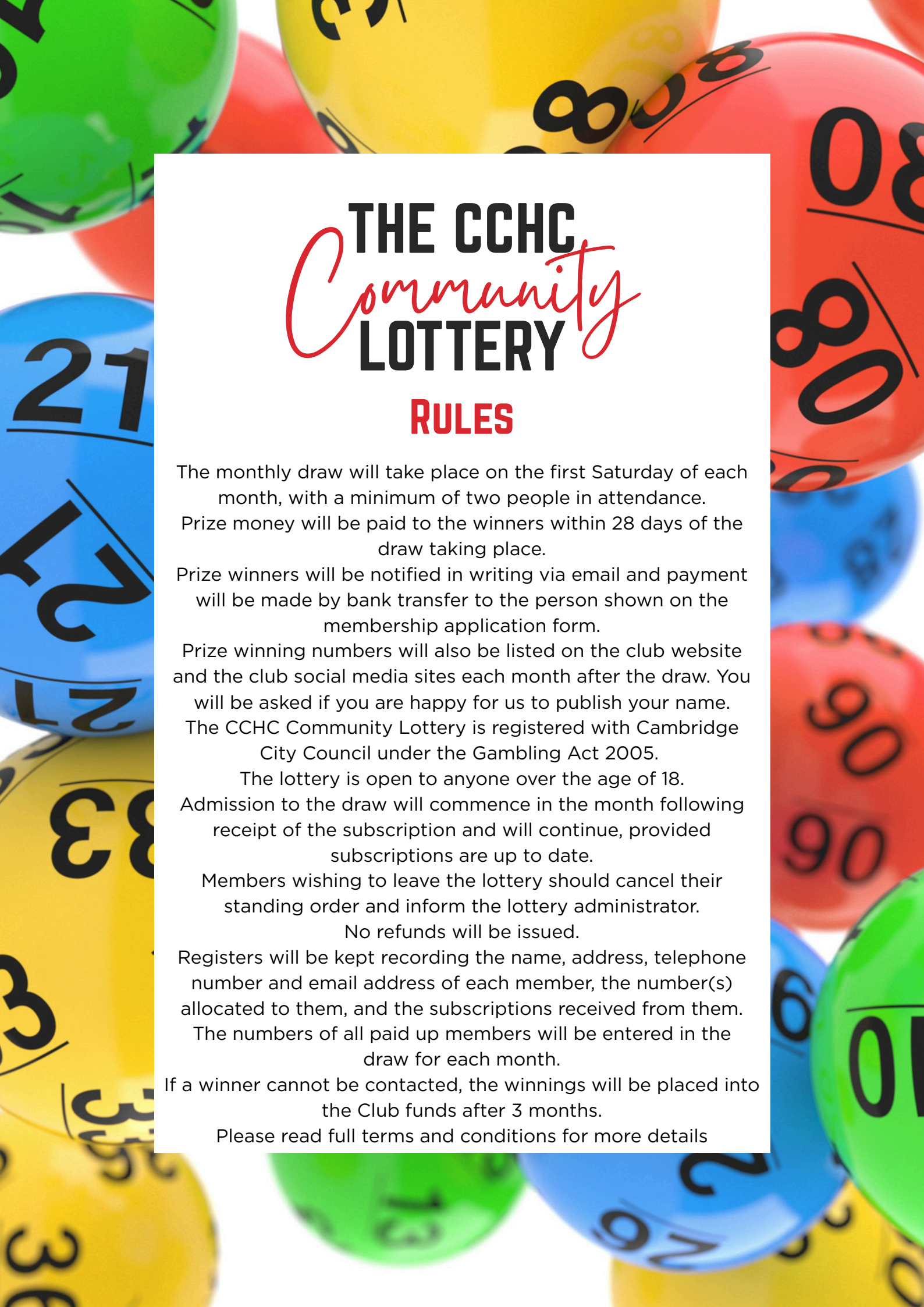

RULES

The monthly draw will take place on the first Saturday of each month, with a minimum of two people in attendance.

Prize money will be paid to the winners within 28 days of the draw taking place.

Prize winners will be notified in writing via email and payment will be made by bank transfer to the person shown on the membership application form.

Prize winning numbers will also be listed on the club website and the club social media sites each month after the draw. You will be asked if you are happy for us to publish your name.

The CCHC Community Lottery is registered with Cambridge City Council under the Gambling Act 2005.

The lottery is open to anyone over the age of 18.

Admission to the draw will commence in the month following receipt of the subscription and will continue, provided subscriptions are up to date.

Members wishing to leave the lottery should cancel their standing order and inform the lottery administrator.

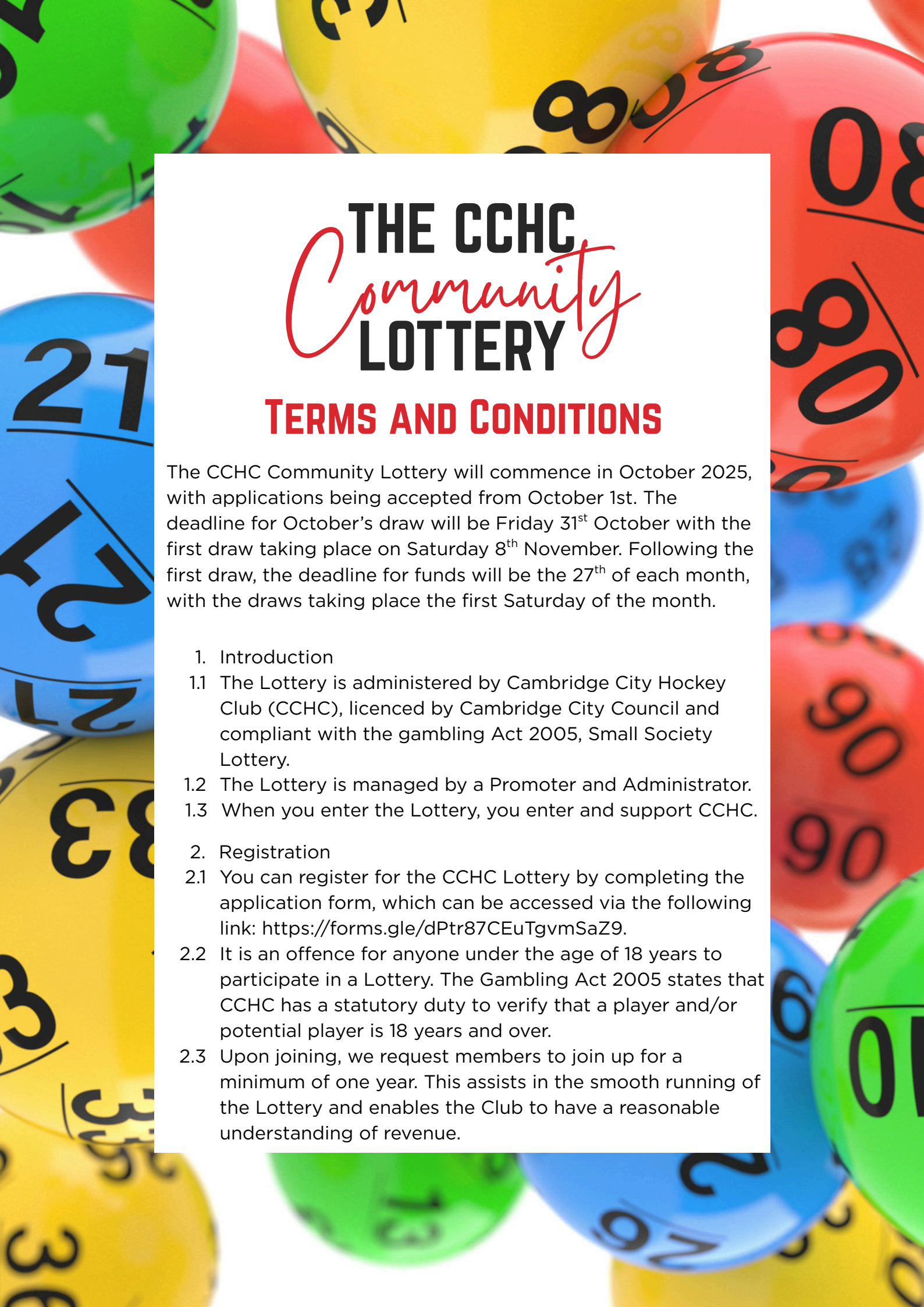
No refunds will be issued.

Registers will be kept recording the name, address, telephone number and email address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them, and the subscriptions received from them.

The numbers of all paid up members will be entered in the draw for each month.

If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the Club funds after 3 months.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The CCHC Community Lottery will commence in October 2025, with applications being accepted from October 1st. The deadline for October's draw will be Friday 31st October with the first draw taking place on Saturday 8th November. Following the first draw, the deadline for funds will be the 27th of each month, with the draws taking place the first Saturday of the month.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Lottery is administered by Cambridge City Hockey Club (CCHC), licenced by Cambridge City Council and compliant with the gambling Act 2005, Small Society Lottery.
- 1.2 The Lottery is managed by a Promoter and Administrator.
- 1.3 When you enter the Lottery, you enter and support CCHC.

2. Registration

- 2.1 You can register for the CCHC Lottery by completing the application form, which can be accessed via the following link: <https://forms.gle/dPtr87CEuTgvmSaZ9>.
- 2.2 It is an offence for anyone under the age of 18 years to participate in a Lottery. The Gambling Act 2005 states that CCHC has a statutory duty to verify that a player and/or potential player is 18 years and over.
- 2.3 Upon joining, we request members to join up for a minimum of one year. This assists in the smooth running of the Lottery and enables the Club to have a reasonable understanding of revenue.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (CONT.)

- 2.4 You can join at any time. We ask that the first payment is received by the 27th day of the month you join.
- 2.5 Registration will require you to provide the following information:
 - Your name, address, e-mail address and telephone number, the number of entries into the lottery you wish to purchase and confirmation you are over 18 years of age.
- 2.6 Payment should be made by bank transfer (preferred option) or by cheque.
- 2.7 When setting up a bank transfer it is essential you use the Bank Account details detailed on the google form. CCHC has more than one account and failure to use the nominated account could result in delays and your lottery number not being entered into the monthly draw. CCHC will not be held responsible in this circumstance.
- 2.8 Bank transfers must be set up for payment to be made on or before the 27th day of each month with LOT+[Your Surname]+[Number of monthly tickets] (example: LOT Smith 2) as the reference.
- 2.9 If payment is made by cheque a full year's membership into the Lottery is required. (No refund given).
- 2.10 Once each monthly payment has been received, your number(s) will be entered into the draw. If payment is not received by the 30th day of each month, you will be notified and removed from the draw for that month.
- 2.11 If payment is made by cheque, we will inform you when your cheque has cleared and the date of when your number(s) will commence to be entered into the draw.
- 2.12 No application is deemed to have been accepted unless and until players have submitted a valid, completed Application Form via the google form and payment by bank transfer or cheque has been cleared into the correct CCHC bank account.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (CONT.)

- 2.13 CCHC reserves the right not to accept an application or to cancel an existing subscription at our discretion. Any such rejection or cancellation may be reconsidered on submission of a written appeal to us.
- 2.14 It is your responsibility as the player to advise us of any change of address or other membership details deemed necessary.
3. Entry and Verification
- 3.1 Only registered tickets will be entered into the Lottery.
- 3.2 You may not purchase or claim to purchase a lottery ticket on behalf of another person.
- 3.3 Members and officers of CCHC are not precluded from playing the Lottery.
- 3.4 Entries that have been purchased and entered into the draw for which they were intended cannot be subsequently refunded.
- 3.5 By entering the Lottery, you agree to be bound by the Rules and applicable provisions of the Gambling Act 2005.
- 3.6 The Rules may be amended by CCHC from time to time.
4. Payment
- 4.1 The price for each entry is £2 per monthly draw.
- 4.2 There is no limit to the number of tickets one person may purchase.
- 4.3 Payment can be made via bank transfer or cheque (as described in 2.7-2.9 above).
- 4.4 Bank transfers are to be referenced as LOT+[Your Surname]+[Number of monthly tickets] (example: LOT Smith 2)
- 4.5 Ticket payments made on or before the 27th of the month will go into the draw held on the first Saturday of the following month.
- 4.6 Entries will cease when no further payments are received.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (CONT.)

5. Draws

- 5.1 The draw will normally take place on the first Saturday of each month.
- 5.2 The draw will take place in the Pavilion at Wilberforce Road. However, a different venue may be used when deemed necessary, or in unforeseen circumstances (e.g., in the summer months when no Saturday hockey is taking place).
- 5.3 If the draw does not take place at Wilberforce Road, it will take place at another appointed venue or via a live zoom event.
- 5.4 The winning numbers will be drawn from an automated random number generator.
- 5.5 There will be at least two people in attendance when the draw takes place.
- 5.6 The first number drawn will be the 1st prize, the second number the 2nd prize and the third number the 3rd prize.

6. Prizes

- 6.1 The prize fund is based on the number of players entered and paid up by the 28th day of each month.
- 6.2 40% of money received per month will be allocated in prize money in the following format:
 - 1st prize = 25% of total revenue received in the month of the draw
 - 2nd prize = 10% of total revenue received in the month of the draw
 - 3rd prize = 5% of total revenue received in the month of the draw.
- 6.3 Prize winners will be notified within 7 days by email in the first instance, or by post or telephone if required.
- 6.4 Payment will be made within 28 days of the draw taking place.
- 6.5 The winning numbers will be published on the CCHC website and other social media platforms.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (CONT.)

- 6.6 The names of winners will only be published if agreed by the winner.
- 6.7 All winnings will be paid by means of direct bank transfer into the player's account.
- 6.8 If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the club funds after 3 months.
- 6.9 CCHC reserves the right to withhold the payment of any prize until it is entirely satisfied that the player who has won the prize has fully complied with the rules.
- 6.10 CCHC reserves the right to amend the prizes at any time. Any such changes will be published on the website at least one month prior to the change being made.
- 6.11 All proceeds, less prize money, and the annual Licence Fee (£40 in the first year, £20 in renewal years) will contribute 100% to the ongoing running of Cambridge City Hockey Club.
- 7. Entry Cancellation
 - 7.1 We request that all participants take up a minimum 12-month membership.
 - 7.2 After this period, you may cancel your entry into the lottery by notifying the Lottery Administrator by emailing cchc.monthlydraw@gmail.com.
 - 7.3 Upon receipt of your request, CCHC will confirm your cancellation and inform you that your data has been removed from the Lottery database.
 - 7.4 Any regular payments set up must be cancelled directly with your bank. CCHC is unable to cancel standing orders on behalf of players. If we continue to receive payment, you will continue to be entered into draws.
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TERMS AND CONDITIONS (CONT.)

7.6 CCHC will not be able to issue refunds.

8. Admin

- 8.1 The Administrator of the CCHC Lottery is Mrs Elizabeth McDade (cchc.monthlydraw@gmail.com).
- 8.2 The Promoter of the CCHC Lottery is Mrs Sarah Rye (cchc.drawpromoter@gmail.com).
- 8.3 The CCHC Lottery is registered with Cambridge City Council under the Gambling Act 2005.
- 8.4 A 'return' will be made no later than every three months to Cambridge City Council licensing department, detailing how much money the CCHC Lottery has raised, total prize money paid and any associated costs

9. Data Privacy

- 9.1 CCHC is committed to protecting your privacy. A copy of our Data Privacy Policy can be found on CCHC website. We will always aim to comply with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) when dealing with personal data.
- 9.2 Players' data will be stored securely by the Administrator.
- 9.3 Data we collect from you will be used lawfully in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018.
- 9.4 We will only collect the minimum data required to carry out the necessary processes to administer the Lottery.
- 9.5 We will not share your personal data with other third parties, except when required to do so by law.
- 9.6 Any members' data which is out of date will be securely deleted.
- 9.7 When a player is no longer a member of the CCHC Lottery, their data will be securely deleted.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (CONT.)

10. Complaints
 - 10.1 Any complaints relating to the Lottery should be sent in writing to the Promoter, Sarah Rye (cchc.drawpromoter@gmail.com) giving full details of the complaint and supporting documentation.
 - 10.2 All complaints and disputes will be dealt with in accordance with our Terms and conditions.
 - 10.3 In the event a dispute cannot be resolved, then it may be referred to the Independent Betting Adjudication Service (IBAS), which is a free service. IBAS contact details are IBAS, PO BOX 62639, London, EC3P 3AS.
11. Changes
 - 11.1 CCHC reserves the right to amend or modify these terms at any time. You will be notified of material changes. Minor changes will be displayed on CCHC website. You are therefore advised to regularly check the Terms and Conditions for such alterations.
