CHANGING ROOM RULES

ECB: Cricket is unusual in that children (under 18s) play, compete, practice, train and socialise amongst adults.

- Junior players should be encouraged to arrive and leave in their playing kit so that they are not required to change or shower at the ground.
- If an adult team includes junior players, the junior players are to change first, without adults in the changing room, including coaches and parents.
- If a team is mixed gender, then female players are to change first, without male players in the changing rooms.

- This guidance applies to transgender, non-binary and other players as well, for whom suitable and comfortable arrangements need to be made.
- Mobile phones or any other equipment capable of capturing still or moving images must not be used in the changing room when people are changing.
- Juniors aged 16 and over may wish to change/shower alongside adults in communal changing rooms. This is ONLY permitted when agreed in advance between the junior player, the player's parent / guardian and the Club Safeguarding Officer. This arrangement will be documented for future reference.
- If access to a changing room is essential, this should be announced verbally before entering.
- Any concerns or queries can be raised with the Club Safeguarding Officer.
