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On a matchday, you'll be expected to work with your coaches and your captain to allow the referee to manage the game without being subjected to abuse.

The league you play in adopts the Respect programme and you will be asked to read, agree to, and sign, a Code of Conduct at your club.

This will be your 'promise' to abide by a set of rules governing your behaviour as a player. Working together with your coach, your captain, and each referee that takes charge of your games during the season, you can play a major role in improving the game for everyone, through Respect.

These codes of conduct apply to all players associated with Borough Green Junior Football Club.

- Make every effort to develop your skills/technique/tactics and fitness;
- Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during a game, regardless of results;
- No abusive or foul language to be used;
- Ensure fair play;
- Always respect the match official's decisions;
- Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally;
- Treat opponents with respect at all times, irrespective of the result of the game;
- No bullying players on other teams or players on their own team;
- Abide by the instructions of the coach;
- Ensure that the rules and the spirit of the game are applied

Any player found to be guilty of ignoring the code of conduct will have their membership with the club reviewed, which could result in a warning/ suspension/or expulsion;

Players should also be aware that the club has a Child Welfare Officer who they can contact should they have any concerns at all.
