The 2026/2027 season will bring continued efforts to strengthen coaching & player development through ongoing coach development initiatives and programming such as skills and goalkeeper training, improvement of the training & playing environment @ Warwick Academy with phased upgrades to additional flood lighting & equipment resources, creating greater efficiency with the administration & communication of the club by increasing and engaging the volunteer base, and fostering the community spirit of WFA.

WFA 2026/2027 SEASON - REGISTRATION GUIDE FOR RETURNING & NEW PLAYERS



Our Registration for the 2026/2027 season is **now open**.



The first registration phase is open to returning WFA players from the 2025/2026 season opting to register for the next season. **The dedicated time for the re-enrolment period expires at midnight on Saturday June 20th, 2026.**



After the re-enrolment period, registration will then be opened to new players wishing to join the WFA program.

All players will receive an indication of placement in the age group player pool for the 2026/2027 program registration after completing the registration opt in offer for the new season. **Registration is not complete until the deposit payment for the 2026/2027 is received.**

We will provide a forecast of the potential number of teams in each age group once registrations numbers are received, along with the assigned pool of staff & volunteer coaches who will be working with the players.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Q: What is the purpose of the season opt-in?
A: It helps us confirm your intent to play with WFA for the 2026/2027 season, so we can secure your place in the player pool.



Q: Is this my child's registration?
A: Yes, this is part of the registration process for returning players. Registration is not complete until payment is completed, and a submission for uniform needs is completed.



Q: What happens after I opt-in?
A: You will need to complete the deposit payment to secure your place in the pool, and an email will be sent with next steps.



Q: Can I change my answer later?
A: Yes, you can change your answer any time until the re-enrolment period deadline by following the steps above.



Q: Can I select a different answer for different children?
A: Yes, you can opt in (or out) individually for each child.



Q: I didn't receive a pop up asking if I want to opt-in or out. What should I do?
A: Please log out and log back into TeamO. If you still don't see the pop up option to opt-in, contact the WFA Administrator.

PLAYER POOL ASSESSMENTS & TEAM ASSIGNMENTS

Player Pool Assessments & Specific Team Roster Assignments for 2026/2027 Season

Player pool assessments of accepted and registered players will take place at the end of August and into early September prior to the BFA team registration date.

Following this process, players will be assigned to specific team rosters for the 2026/2027 season.



SUMMER & PRE-SEASON CAMP & TRAINING



Player pools will begin receiving optional training opportunities during August to help players sharpen their skills ahead of formal pre-season activities.



These sessions also provide opportunities for players and coaches within each age-group pool to begin building relationships before the season begins.



Training frequency will initially be once per week before increasing as the return to school approaches.

Registration with WFA for the 2026/2027 season is not complete and confirmed until a deposit payment has been received via online bank transfer for all players.

-  Returning players from the 2025/2026 season can process the deposit payment immediately once completing the **Opt-In** option for the 2026/2027 season via **TeamO**. All deposit payments and uniform charges are to be paid via online transfer.
-  **New Registration & Transfer Players** will make the deposit payment via online transfer once you receive a confirmation email from us to verify placement in the program.
-  The balance of fees for all **Warwick Academy students** for the WFA 2026/2027 season, parents have the option to be billed to the student's account for payment on September 1st statements from Warwick Academy, or parents can elect to make the payment in full via online transfer.
-  The balance of fees for **non-Warwick Academy students** for the WFA 2026/2027 season will be payable via online bank transfer prior to September 1, 2026.
