Subscription Change - EH affiliation fees.

For the coming season England Hockey have made significant changes to the method of calculating affiliation fees, and what they fund. At the AGM this was reviewed in detail, and the impact it would have on the Club.

The bottom line is that while England Hockey will increase its activities to grow the game, the financial impact is that our affiliation fees (which include Club and Member insurance) will rise from £4,800 to £9,800.

THE PLAYER REGISTRATION FEE The proposed Player Registration Fee will be £16 for teen and adult players and £10 for U12s. This fee applies to all regular players and includes the following benefits: England Hockey Registration Fee - Benefits for Players % of Cost / year Your Hockey Benefits (teen & adult) Mandatory Registration Personal Accident Insurance You 60% £10 Exclusive discounts (e.g. Opro) Ticket offers - first chance Free coaching, officiating and Your Game safeguarding courses up to £3 recognised standards Free to air hockey National fund for State School 20% £3 & more inclusive hockey

This change was approved at the EH AGM,

Please note:

- 1. Subs must be paid by 30th September 2025
- 2. Goalkeepers using kit provided by the club shall pay full subs for their age group
- 3. Any juniors playing adult games shall pay £8 match fees
- 4. Match fees to be paid in full on the day of the match through Teamo

There will be no changes to match fees, and all Club Umpires who are Level 1 qualified and registered on GMS will be able to claim £14 per match.

Umpiring


