


Directions and Car Parking Arrangements for Winchester Sports Stadium- University of Winchester

Bar End Road – Winchester – SO23 0QA

Unfortunately, there is no general player parking at the Bar End facility (Unless disabled blue badge). Cars parking without a pass will be ticketed. (You have been warned – and please be aware that street parking in Milland Road and area is now permit only until 22:00!).

There is Parking for Officials, Umpires (SCO & Club) and disabled Blue Badge holders – please register at reception and collect an authorised temporary parking permit for WHC Hockey. (Please return it).

Car Parking for all players and visitors, match day and coaching sessions, is at the Barfield Park & ride, accessed just off the B3404 Bar End Rd, (turn left at the mini roundabout) – use SO23 9SQ for SatNav. Pedestrian access to the Bar End pitch for all players is by a pathway through the Garrison grounds off Bar End Road. Walk back to the Bar end road, cross the road by the mini roundabout using the crossing, and go straight across onto the path that takes you through the new Sports Centre and on towards the athletics track & pitch. Parking at the park and ride costs £1.50 for 3 hours on a Saturday & Sunday, or £2.70 per day at all other times.




Access to the University Bar End pitch is:-

- From the north, leave M3 at junction 9 (**there is no exit at J10**).
- From the south, leave M3 at junction 10. and follow B3404 Bar End Road into Winchester.

Follow directions to Barfield Park and Ride, which is a left turn at the mini roundabout off Bar End Road, just past the Garage, (into Barfield Close).
