

OUR VISITORS:

MAINE ROAD

THE CLUB'S INCEPTION DATES BACK TO 1955 WHEN IT WAS ESTABLISHED BY MANCHESTER CITY FANS, ORIGINALLY DUBBED AS CITY SUPPORTERS RUSHOLME. INITIAL ACTIVITIES COMPRISED FRIENDLY MATCHES UNTIL ENTRY INTO THE RUSHOLME SUNDAY LEAGUE. THIS AFFILIATION PERSISTED UNTIL 1966, WHEN THE CLUB TRANSITIONED TO THE MANCHESTER AMATEUR SUNDAY LEAGUE. DURING THIS PERIOD, THE CLUB ALSO RELOCATED ITS BASE TO THE MAINE ROAD SOCIAL CLUB AND ASSUMED THE NEW IDENTITY OF MAINE ROAD FOOTBALL CLUB.

THE YEAR 1971-72 MARKED A NOTABLE TURNING POINT AS MAINE ROAD CLINCHED VICTORY IN BOTH THE MANCHESTER COUNTY SUNDAY CUP AND THE LEAGUE CHAMPIONSHIP. SUBSEQUENTLY, THE CLUB SHIFTED ITS FOCUS TO SATURDAY FOOTBALL AND SECURED A PLACE IN DIVISION TWO OF THE MANCHESTER LEAGUE. THEIR ENTRANCE INTO DIVISION TWO WAS TRIUMPHANT, SWIFTLY EARNING THEM THE TITLE AND A PROMOTION TO DIVISION ONE, ACCOMPANIED BY A WIN IN THE MANCHESTER COUNTY AMATEUR CUP. CONTINUING THEIR STRIDE, THEY SECURED DIVISION ONE CHAMPIONSHIP THE SUBSEQUENT SEASON, CONSEQUENTLY ADVANCING TO THE PREMIER DIVISION.

NOTEWORTHY ACHIEVEMENTS PERSISTED INTO THE 1975-76 SEASON, WITH MAINE ROAD CAPTURING THE MANCHESTER PREMIER CUP BY PREVAILING OVER ABBEY HEY WMC IN THE FINAL. THE FEAT WAS REPEATED IN THE ENSUING SEASON AGAINST LITTLE LEVER. THE PINNACLE WAS REACHED IN THE 1982-83 SEASON AS THE CLUB SEIZED THE PREMIER DIVISION CHAMPIONSHIP. THIS ACCOMPLISHMENT WAS SUSTAINED FOR THREE SUCCESSIVE SEASONS, FOLLOWED BY A RUNNER-UP POSITION IN 1986-87, PROMPTING THEIR ASCENT TO DIVISION TWO OF THE NORTH WEST COUNTIES LEAGUE.

THE INITIAL FORAY INTO THE NORTH WEST COUNTIES LEAGUE INDUCTED MAINE ROAD AS CONTENDERS. THEY CLINCHED THE MANCHESTER PREMIER CUP FOR THE THIRD TIME, SECURING A 1-0 VICTORY OVER IRLAM TOWN IN THE FINAL. A COMMENDABLE DIVISION TWO RUNNERS-UP POSITION IN 1988-89 DID NOT RESULT IN PROMOTION DUE TO UNMET GROUND GRADING STANDARDS. NEVERTHELESS, THE SUBSEQUENT SEASON WITNESSED THEIR TRIUMPHANT CLAIM OF THE DIVISION TWO TITLE, PAVING THE WAY TO DIVISION ONE. 1998-99 MARKED THEIR APPEARANCE AS FINALISTS IN THE MANCHESTER PREMIER CUP. DESPITE A RELEGATION AT THE CLOSE OF THE 2001-02 SEASON, THEY STAGED A COMEBACK WITH A DIVISION TWO RUNNERS-UP POSITION IN 2003-04, PROPELLING THEM BACK TO DIVISION ONE, AND ONCE AGAIN ENTERING THE MANCHESTER PREMIER CUP FINAL.

THE CLUB'S ACHIEVEMENTS PERSISTED AS THEY SECURED THE LEAGUE'S CHALLENGE CUP IN 2007-08, LEADING TO THE RENAMING OF DIVISION ONE TO THE PREMIER DIVISION. MAINTAINING THEIR MOMENTUM, THEY SECURED A PREMIER DIVISION RUNNERS-UP POSITION IN 2013-14.
