# Today's Opponents

## *Cheadle Town FC*



A look at our opponents, who we faced just seven days ago; we visited The Ground Up Solutions Stadium last Tuesday, claiming a narrow 2-1 victory in what was difficult conditions for game.

Heres a close look at Jake Davies' team.

### **Early Years**

Cheadle Town began life in 1961 as Grasmere Rovers, competing in the Manchester & District Sunday Football League at the Under-16 level. The club quickly grew in stature, winning the Under-21 Championship in 1968, followed by the Premier Division title two years later.

In 1972, the club transitioned to Saturday football by joining the Manchester Football League. Success continued under manager Albert Pike, who took over in 1978. In his first full season, Pike led the team to a remarkable double: First Division Champions and Manchester Amateur Cup winners. The club would later also lift both the Manchester & Derbyshire FA Cups.

### **Move to Park Road & Name Change**

In 1982, Grasmere Rovers moved into their own ground at Park Road Stadium. The following year, the club rebranded as Cheadle Town and joined the North West Counties Football League (NWCFL). Most of their time was spent in the Second Division, with promotion to the First Division achieved in 1996. Relegation followed in 2001, a position they held until 2023, when the club was promoted to the newly named Premier Division.

### **Park Road Stadium Highlights**

Park Road Stadium has a storied past. Originally home to Cheadle Rovers, it was later used by Manchester City as a training ground. Notably, Portugal and Eusebio trained there during the 1966 World Cup. In 1993, Brazilian legend Jairzinho hosted a Soccer School for Cheadle Town.

# Today's Opponents

## *Cheadle Town FC*



Floodlights were added in 1995, inaugurated with a memorable match against Manchester United's youth team, where Town won 3-2 in front of nearly 2,000 fans. The club's largest domestic attendance came in 2005 against FC United of Manchester, with 3,227 spectators at Edgeley Park witnessing a thrilling 3-3 draw.

### **Legendary Tours**

Cheadle Town is renowned for its international tours, having played 96–97 games across 30 countries, scoring 111 goals in front of over 312,000 fans. Touring under the name Manchester AFC, they faced seven national sides and once played in front of 65,000 at Mexico City's Aztec Stadium. Notable figures who have met the club include Alfredo di Stefano, Ronnie Biggs, Jairzinho, and Rajiv Gandhi, across destinations from Cannes to Phuket.

### **Milestones & Achievements**

50th Anniversary (2011): Kit colours changed to green, honoring Grasmere Rovers.

FA Accreditation: Recognized as an England Football Accredited Club (formerly FA Charter Standard Community).

2018 Developments: Became part of Little Sports Group, owned by ex-player Craig Brennan, and received a £50,000 Buildbase improvement bursary to enhance facilities.

### **Recent Success**

The 2019–20 and 2020–21 seasons were disrupted by COVID-19, but hopes rose in 2022/23 with the appointment of Paul Marshall and Steve Yarwood. Paul brought professional experience from clubs including Manchester City, Blackpool, and Aberdeen, while Steve added extensive semi-professional knowledge.

The 2022/23 season was historic: for the first time in over 20 years, Cheadle Town was promoted to the NWCFL top tier.

# Today's Opponents

## *Cheadle Town FC*



The team earned 'Club of the Month' three times, set records for unbeaten runs and consecutive wins, and triumphed 3-1 in the playoff final against Sandbach United in front of 1,375 supporters, with Martin Pilkington scoring in injury time.

### Looking Ahead

Cheadle Town now embarks on an exciting new era at Step 5 of the football pyramid, building on a rich legacy of domestic success, international tours, and community impact.
