As of February 17, 2025, all members of Copenhagen Netball Club have a 5-digit member number, which is generated automatically at random by Teamo. Numbers are taken from Teamo Members Section, where the field "Teamo Id (unique)" can be viewed, and the last 5 digits are used to allow for enough variability.

If you do not know your member number, please contact one of the Board members, and they can look it up for you in document "Club Member Numbers" which can be found in the Google Drive.

The purpose of the member number is to assist bookkeeping in regards to payments made to the club. Too often we receive payments to the club that is missing information such as who sent it, and what it is for.

To help with this, whenever someone transfers money to the club via internet banking, when filling out the details and you have to provide "text to show on receivers account", you have to include your member number and payment code, separated by a hyphen "-".

Payment code:

There are only a few things that get paid to the club regularly: membership fees and for club gear (jumper/hoodies). But as things go on, and we start having more gear, and payments for tournaments, we needed a way to track what payments are for.

Each payment type will have a 3-digit code, as shown in the list below, which will be updated over time.

Example, your member number is 12345, and you're paying for a full-year adult membership, you would write in the text box which will show up in the receivers account: 12345-101.

This way the Treasurer can search through payments in the bank statements using someone's member number, or to see how many payments have been received for, eg, youth memberships.
