- 1) **For Adult, Occasional, Concessionary (over 18), Associate and Honorary Life Members** you accept and/or acknowledge:
 - i) that as a member of Harleston Magpies Hockey Club Limited (a company Limited by Guarantee) you agree to pay a sum of £1 in the event of the winding up of the company.
 - ii) the **Club's Codes of Conduct and Policy Documents** on the club website under **Club Policies and Guidelines**. NB - Please regularly look at the website to see updates to versions of Codes of Conduct and Policy Documents.
 - iii) the club's full **Data Privacy Policy**, which we are working towards, which can be accessed on the website under **Club Policies and Guidelines**.
 - iv) with respect to **photography**, in some environments, particularly adult competition it is impossible to control photography by external parties. However, there may be times that photographs and/or footage may be taken during matches and training sessions by approved agents and/or officers of Harleston Magpies Hockey Club. Photographs taken as per the above may appear in the press, on the club notice board, club website or club social media.
 - v) you are registering for membership of the club – rather than paying for a service – hence subscription fees are non-refundable.
 - vi) if your subscriptions or match fees are in arrears the club reserves the right to withhold the benefits of membership
 - vii) your membership only allows you (or your child) access to club facilities when they are open for activities organised by the club.
- 2) **For Parents/Carers of Youth and Junior Members** - you accept and/or acknowledge:
 - i) the **Club's Codes of Conduct and Policy Documents** on the club website under **Club Policies and Guidelines**. NB - Please regularly look at the website to see updates to versions of Codes of Conduct and Policy Documents (including Young Persons Guide and Parents/Legal Guardians Guide).
 - ii) with respect to **transportation** - you understand it is not the club's responsibility to transport your child to and from fixtures, and you have no objection to other parents/carers, adults or players associated with the club transporting the above to tournaments/matches. (If you do object, it is your responsibility to provide transportation on all occasions when your child is selected for a team).
 - iii) with respect to **photography**, in some environments, particularly adult competition it is impossible to control photography by external parties. However, there may be times that photographs and/or footage may be taken during matches and training sessions by approved agents and/or officers of Harleston Magpies Hockey Club. Photographs taken as per the above may appear in the press, on the club notice board, club website or club social media.
 - iv) the club's full **Data Privacy Policy**, which we are working towards, which can be accessed via the website under **Club Policies and Guidelines**.

- v) with respect to **medical information for all under 18s** - Parents and Carers are requested to keep up to date any relevant medical information on the relevant club database - **but it is also very important that Parents and Carers keep coaches, managers and (adult) team captains directly informed**, of children's medical conditions as access to the database may not be available in some environments.
 - vi) that all Parents and Carers are reminded that:
 - at training sessions, they are expected to remain on the club grounds whilst training takes place - unless they nominate another named responsible adult in the event of an issue arising (e.g., injury).
 - for minis tournaments (U8s, U10s and U12s) - they are expected to remain at the venue with their child - unless they nominate another named responsible adult in the event of an issue arising (and have notified the relevant manager or coach).
 - at training sessions for younger age groups - they (or a nominated responsible adult) should be available to escort children across the car park to the toilets/club house (coaches need to remain on the pitch to supervise other children).
