

WELCOME TO THE NEST

It is a warm welcome to Guildford H.C. and their supporters, for their visit to the Nest today. We are also pleased to welcome today's umpires, Lucy Barlow and David Eggleton, together with match official Yvonne McCartney. We thank you for giving up your time today.

Magpies were relegated after their game away at Southgate two weeks ago, as a 3-0 defeat sealed our fate. It would be fair to say that it wasn't one of their best performances but to the squad's credit they never gave up. When the final whistle blew, it was clear to see the disappointment as relegation was confirmed. The reality is that it wasn't this game that got the team relegated, as over the course of the season, we just haven't been good enough.

Last Saturday the team travelled to South London to face Surbiton and with the pressure seemingly off, they were immediately on the attack, resulting in Lauren Rowe firing home an early short corner. Unfortunately we weren't in front for long as a defensive error resulted in a Surbiton equaliser. Beth Cordukes put Magpies ahead again following one of her solo runs before firing past the Surbiton goalkeeper but again Surbiton levelled the game at 2 all. Captain Hannah de Selincourt fired home from the top of the D on 18 minutes but again Surbiton equalised just before half time to leave the game level at 3 each. Sadly Magpies couldn't find another goal and Surbiton scored the winner from a late short corner to secure the points. Jess Smith was named player of the match after another outstanding performance and her progression this season has been brilliant to watch.

It was a bitter pill to swallow but we were happy to score 3 goals for the first time this season and hopefully this week against Guildford, we can tighten up in defence and please the home crowd with a win. There is still plenty to play for in the last 3 games of the season, as the group are determined to finish strongly with a view to taking this momentum into a promotion push next season.

There is a tremendous amount of hard work that goes on behind the scenes to provide the excellent facilities and playing opportunities here at Magpies. Countless hours are spent by members, supporters of the club and the whole squad offer thanks to these volunteers for their efforts throughout the season.
