


WELCOME TO THE NEST

Two weeks ago Exeter were very relieved to be making the long journey home with a hard earned three points. Magpies went 1-0 up from a Lauren Barber short corner early in the game which was a massive confidence boost to the group. Exeter hit back 12 minutes later to level the game and unfortunately for Magpies they were caught out twice more before half time to be 3-1 down. The 3rd quarter proved to be fairly even with Magpies unable to capitalise on any of their opportunities. At the start of the 4th quarter, Magpies threw caution to the wind and played without a goalkeeper. They moved the ball about the pitch at a great speed and put Exeter under intense pressure. Despite the visitors netting their 4th goal, Magpies never let their intensity drop. This was typified by Beth Cordukes, who covered every inch of the pitch before scoring the goal of the game. She made a determined run through the Exeter defence before flicking the ball into the roof of the net past the advancing goalkeeper.

If Magpies can play 70 minutes against Reading with the same speed and intensity as they did in the last quarter of this game, they will surely gain their first points of the season to kick start our move up the table.
