

# **WELCOME TO THE NEST**

It is a warm welcome to Southgate H.C. and their supporters, for their visit to the Nest today. We are also pleased to welcome today's umpires, Stuart Freeman, Mark Oldfield, together with match official Yvonne McCarthey. We thank you for giving up your time today.

Magpies record since the last home game is played 3 lost 3 but for the old hands in the team know this is nothing new. With 8 new players, it was always going to take time for the team to get to know each other and start to gel as a unit. However judging by the noise levels and smiles on faces at training there are no signs that confidence is low. Against Teddington Magpies were disappointed not to get any points from the game having had a good share of the ball over the 70 minutes and having created some good chances. Unfortunately Magpies lost captain Ella Picton to another twisted ankle just before half time. Everybody was devastated to see her hobbling off the pitch again as she has been back to her best again having suffered so many injuries, including a concussion over the last 3 years. She is likely to be out until at least Xmas which is a massive loss to the team.

Next up was Exeter away with a 3 o'clock start, so we had an overnight stay in Bristol before resuming the journey to Devon. Although the team worked tirelessly and never stopped working for each other, they just couldn't create enough sustained pressure on the home team defence. They went 2 down but Magpies did get 1 back with a slick move down the left that was finished by Hannah de Selincourt. With time running out, they pushed for the equalizer but lost possession and Exeter finished the game off with a decisive counter attack. The game will be remembered for the brilliant debut of Rita Box who missed the first 2 games with a broken nose. She showed just what an exciting talent she is with her forward runs from the right side of defence.

Last week at Reading it would be fair to say they were the better team and a 1-0 loss was a bit flattering to Magpies. But despite being outplayed for long periods Magpies showed great resilience in defence to thwart the Reading attacks and in the end it was a top class finish with a reverse stick strike into the roof of the net that seperated the sides. Sadly Magpies injury woes mounted when Rita Box limped off having twisted her knee but she trained on Wednesday and it is hoped that she will be fit enough to play a part in the game against Southgate.

Magpies will be looking forward to playing Southgate with home support after 2 weeks on the road .The team are full of confidence and hope that all the hard work put in on the training pitch with coach Simon Letchford, will be rewarded with points against Southgate today.

There is a tremendous amount of hard work that goes on behind the scenes to provide the excellent facilities and playing opportunities here at Magpies. Countless hours are spent by members, supporters of the club and the whole squad offer thanks to these volunteers for their efforts throughout the season.




