

They arrive here today having made a quiet start to the season. Having drawn 3 of their first 5 games, they will also feel that their results are not reflective of their efforts to date. However we took 4 points from our games against the visitors last season so we are looking for some positive reward reward for our efforts today.

Hannah De Selincourt and Rita Box are missing from today's line up although Holly Hartley returns to the squad. Sadly it has been confirmed Rita has a Grade 1 ACL tear so will be out until at least February. A big loss to the team and very disappointing for Rita in her debut season. We wish her well and we all hope for a speedy recovery.
