


WELCOME TO THE NEST

It is a warm welcome to University of Exeter H.C. and their supporters, for their visit to the Nest today. We are also pleased to welcome today's umpires, Tony Rollins and Mark Oldfield, together with match official John Snelling. We thank you for giving up your time today.

Magpies are looking forward to the second half of the outdoor season after a successful indoor campaign. It would be fair to say that our initial goal for indoors was to survive in the Premier League for another season. Having won both of our games on day one, against Buckingham and Clifton, expectations were raised a little higher. Day two proved tougher, with two defeats. Losing to Slough in the last minute was a bitter pill to swallow, as we played the better hockey but that's indoor hockey for you. Our hopes were revived after winning 9-0 against Beeston, with Beth Gardens scoring seven but that was to be our last success. Magpies needed another win from their final two games to make the top four. Our return to outdoor action last Saturday saw Magpies travel to top of the table Teddington, looking to kick start this half of the outdoor season with a win. Unfortunately we are now without our rising star defender Immi Dolding after she dislocated her shoulder in a school match (We wish her a speedy recovery) A boost to the squad, saw captain Ella Picton making her comeback, after twisting her ankle earlier in the season.

Sadly, it wasn't the victory we had hoped for but the neutrals watching were surprised that there was such a gap between the two teams in the league. Magpies looked as good as Teddington for long periods of the game but in the vital moments they just came out on top. Magpies were denied from going 1-0 up, when a short corner strike rebounded off the post and to safety. Seconds before half time, Teddington scored from a well worked corner to take a narrow lead into the break. The home side made the game safe in the fourth quarter after a scrappy bit of play, saw Magpies unable to clear the ball away from their D.

One thing is for sure, the squad ran themselves into the ground with only fourteen travelling and they never gave up. With seconds remaining on the clock, we forced the Teddington goalkeeper into a full length save down to her right hand post. It would have probably only been a consolation goal but it proved just how much heart the squad has to keep going right until the final whistle.

Magpies are looking forward to playing second placed Exeter on Saturday and believe if they produce a performance like they did in London, that they will gain their first win of the season. With the vocal home crowd's support behind them, they would dearly like to reward the club with 3 points.

There is a tremendous amount of hard work that goes on behind the scenes to provide the excellent facilities and playing opportunities here at Magpies. Countless hours are spent by members, supporters of the club and the whole squad offer thanks to these volunteers for their efforts throughout the season.


