All Juniors of this Cricket Club will:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of cricket
- Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief
- Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed
- Display high standards of behaviour
- Display high standards of dress
- Be punctual to training and matches
- Promote the positive aspects of cricket, for example fair play
- Thank officials or volunteers for their help
- Encourage all participants to learn the Laws and rules and play within them, always respecting the decisions of match officials
- Actively discourage unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials
- Recognise good performance not just match results
- Never smoke or drink alcohol
- Report any concerns to a responsible adult they may have about a friend or a teammate
